






Fire Alarm linkage is a feature in the WatchNET Access software that releases all doors when an input is triggered on the controller, for example, when Aux input is opened all doors should follow always open schedule, to configure this feature go to "Event Alerts" or go to Setup – Event Alerts – Access Event Alerts.




Click "New Alert" to create an event alert, input the name, select the event, controller and the aux input 1, also input the date and time when you want it to start.





Now click Lock down tab to select all doors and select the status schedule.



Note: After creating the opening condition you would need to create a closing condition to return all doors back to normal schedule.
